We need everyone to start making plans to attend. We will be at the Hot Springs Convention Center. The Hotel Hot Springs and Embassy Suites will be blocking off rooms for the AFMA delegates. We do suggest that you get your rooms early prior to cut off date in December. **REMEMBER this year all registration will be done online. You can find the registration form on the AFMA website. We will activate in November.**

<u>WE ARE OPEN FOR SUGGESTIONS</u>. If you have suggestions for seminars or convention activities, please contact a member of the AFMA Board prior to the June 1, 2024 meeting. We hope to finalize our plans, keeping our website updated with convention details. It is our goal to promote and support Arkansas fairs, to provide AFMA members with beneficial information, and to hold an annual educationally-oriented convention and special meetings.

We want to encourage each fairboard to consider that deserving person who is worthy of getting an award. You can check our website for the guidelines and qualifications for the **Hall of Fame Award, Charles Smith Memorial Award, Mary Louise Fiser Family Award, Lloyd Dunaway Award, and the Work Horse Award.** We ask that nominations be received by October 15, 2024.

Our "Scholarship Quilt" has been a huge success. We are once again asking each fair to provide a 10x10 quilt block. The only requirements other than size is that it be on quilting fabric (not thick) with no embellishments such as beads, sequins, etc. We are also asking that you provide us with a t-shirt with your fair logo. We hope to have a second quilt made from t-shirts to auction off. Deadline for the quilt block and t-shirt is September 1, 2024. Please forward the quilt blocks and t-shirts to Carolyn Wynn, 10757 St Hwy 54E, Star City AR 71667. We hope all seventy-four (74) counties, districts and state will participate.

The Display of Fairs has become a very popular activity at the convention. Sharing of ideas is great, especially when you have a visual to look at. Start now, getting your ideas together using the theme of **AFMA----Courtesy of the Red**, **White, and Blue.** We are already making plans to increase the number of tables required to set up the displays. Also, don't forget that each fair participating will be in a drawing for \$50. There will be three (3) lucky fairs. The favorite display, which will be voted on by the delegates, will receive the "traveling" plaque for one year.

The tradeshow committee is working hard to have a great tradeshow. The weather was a hindrance last year causing some to have to stay home due to snow in the forecast. If you are interested or know someone who might be interested in having booth space please let us know. The booth space is 10x10 with a table, two chairs and signage. Each booth space will be responsible for their own electricity with the convention center. The booth will cost \$150, not requiring you to be an associate member. For those who wish to be an associate member, dues are an additional \$100. Associate members will be listed in the convention directory.

Registration will remain at \$45 per delegate. \$50 is late registration after December 15, 2024. Youth 18 and under will remain at \$10, Associate membership is \$100. Remember, registration will be online with the capability of paying by debit or credit cards. We will activate in November. The banquet tickets will also remain at \$45<u>. YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A REGISTRATION FORM IN THE MAIL.</u>
